General Guidelines:

- Listen to and Obey Workers. Unruly behavior will NOT be tolerated and may result in ban from Recycling Center.
- Workers have the right to refuse ANY waste.
- Recycling Center is for Residential Waste for Town Residents ONLY.
- Town Businesses are to contract their own waste services.
- Residents are limited to One Trip per Saturday.
- Black Bags are NOT permitted.
- Ashes are only accepted in Plastic Bags.
- Bags of recyclables are to be emptied into dumpster.
- Breakdown all cardboard boxes.

Materials NOT Accepted at the Recycling Center:

- Furniture - Couches, Recliners, etc.
- Mattresses / Box Springs
- Stone / Cement Products
- Construction Materials (drywall, wood, shingles)
- Dead Animals (or parts - hides)
- Yard Waste - Brush, Grass Clippings, Leaves
- Hazardous Wastes and Chemicals
- Medical Waste and Needles
- Tires (car, truck, or bike)
- Silage Bags or Twine

Materials Accepted with Fee:

- \$40 - Appliances containing Freon
- \$30 - Computers and Laptops
- \$30 - TVs and Monitors
- \$20 - Printers, Fax Machines, Scanners
- \$20 - Other Miscellaneous Electronics
- \$20 - All other appliances
- \$20 - Large loads (at the discretion of Workers)

Waste (Non-Recyclable) Materials - West Dumpster

- Ceramics
- Window / Auto Glass & Drinking Glasses
- Plastic Toys
- Flower Pots
- Wrappers / Plastic Bags
- Contaminated Paper
- Contaminated Pizza and Carryout Boxes
- Tissue / Paper Toweling
- Kitchen Waste, Food Waste
- Oil Containers and Other Auto Chemical Containers (Must be emptied)
- Light Bulbs
- Fluorescent and Compact Fluorescent Lamps
- Styrofoam

Recyclable Materials - East Dumpster

- Tin Cans
- Glass Jars - Clear (No Window Glass)
- Recyclable Plastic
- Flower Pots
- Paperboard and Cardboard (Must be broken down)
- Newspaper and Other Paper Products

Scrap Metal

- Iron
- Steel
- Other Large Metal Items
- Aerosol, Propane and Other Pressure tanks must be punctured
